

The Department of Medicine (DOM), division of Gastroenterology at Michael Garron Hospital (MGH) is searching for a **FTE** gastroenterologist.

Michael Garron Hospital (MGH) is a member of the Toronto East Health Network (TEHN) and part of a vibrant and highly integrated Ontario Health Team (OHT). MGH is community teaching hospital, affiliated with the University of Toronto, and serves one of Canada's most diverse communities. MGH has 470 beds comprised of acute care, rehabilitation and complex continuing care beds. MGH is in the final stages of a redevelopment project, with a new and state of the art, eight storey Ken and Marilyn Thomson Patient Care Centre scheduled to open in 2022. MGH has longstanding partnerships spanning multiple disciplines with Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre (SHSC) and Odette Cancer Centre.

The successful candidate is expected to have certification in Gastroenterology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and be eligible for licensure in the Province of Ontario. Candidates should have fellowship training and competency in advanced endoscopic procedures including ERCP and management of large polyps. The candidate will provide multidisciplinary consultative care for the full spectrum of GI disorders and share equitably in the GI on-call schedule.

The successful candidate will be expected to demonstrate exceptional interprofessional, interpersonal and collaborative skills and commitment to advance the strategic goals and vision for the DOM and the Division of Gastroenterology. The candidate will be assigned a leadership role for the endoscopy committee and will function to strengthen collaborations with our General Surgery division. The candidate will have the skill set to work with our virtual care leads, within our OHT to facilitate expansion of the FIT program. The candidate will also have the capabilities of further developing collaborations with other hospitals in the TASHN system, particularly with the hepatobiliary group at SHSC. Experience in developing a collaborative endoscopic ultrasound program is considered as a desirable asset. An interest in pursuing scholarly activity including clinical and health outcomes research is strongly encouraged.

The successful candidate will be eligible for an appointment in the Department of Medicine at the University of Toronto at the rank of Lecturer or Assistant Professor, commensurate with their qualification and academic achievement. The candidate must demonstrate a commitment to excellence in education and academic involvement including participating in committees at the hospital and university level.
