We are currently recruiting for a full-time Gastroenterologist

Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre (TBRHSC) is a world-class acute care facility with 375 beds that serves the people of Thunder Bay and Northwestern Ontario. Our region has a population of over 250,000 residents that are scattered over 40% of Ontario's landmass. We offer an expansive range of specialist services and are designated as an academic health sciences centre.

The Division of Gastroenterology at the Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre is currently recruiting for **(1) full-time Gastroenterologist** to join its team.

The successful candidate will join the team of (4) Gastroenterologist's to provide inpatient GI consultation and endoscopy coverage to the hospital and region. On-call requirements are for GI and endoscopy services only. TBRHSC features a busy endoscopy unit that has (4) endoscopy suites with new Olympus equipment. Over 10,000 endoscopy procedures are performed yearly, as well as 450 ERCPs. We also have capability to perform EUS. The candidate can expect to have regular access to endoscopy time and be given an equitable amount of the ERCP cases. TBRHSC also offers a Motility Lab with 24 hr pH testing and esophageal manometry, and a Video Capsule Endoscopy Program.

There is an opportunity to join an established outpatient community practice and share in affordable overhead costs. All endoscopy referrals are triaged through a central intake system and many of the initial consultations are completed by the program's Nurse Practitioners. In addition, the TBRHSC offers direct access to care for patients who are FIT positive or who have a first degree family history of colon cancer. Initial consultations for these indications are completed by a registered nurse.

The successful candidate must have an independent license or be eligible for an independent license with the College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada and have certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Gastroenterology. Preference will also be given to those who possess formal fellowship training and experience in inflammatory bowel disease. All candidates must be either Canadian citizens or permanent residents.
